Our 2007 Viognier returns to a dry white style Rhone wine with lots of complexity from the vineyards. The Honeychurch vineyard in Shenandoah Valley has some of the smallest Viognier berries to be found, and is our most intensely perfumed wine of the blend. Our other selection is from the Fenaughty vineyard high in the hills of El Dorado County. This high country fruit provides a balancing act of bright fruit acid and wonderful minerality. The Roussanne, also from El Dorado County is once again from a unique vineyard setting, as it perches on the edge of a cliff overlooking the South fork of the American river. This cooling effect helps build the intense almond and butterscotch notes in the wine.
